

### **Safe Network Multi-Faith Hub filming**

On Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> June we have made arrangements for a film crew from the NSPCC to attend (activity) to do some filming for a project that the NSPCC is developing as part of the Safe Network service ([www.safenetwork.org.uk](http://www.safenetwork.org.uk)). The crew will be filming footage of the children/young people, leaders and families going about their normal activities as part of the group; in some circumstances they may film some comments made by individual children. All the filming will be done in accordance with the ethical principles and values adopted by the NSPCC.

The film footage will be edited and used as part of Safe Network's Multi-Faith Hub. This is a new, web-based resource aimed at encouraging faith groups and organisations to share good safeguarding practice with each other. It will have space for resources and information that have been developed to apply across the six main faiths practised in the UK:

Islam

Buddhism

Judaism

Hinduism

Sikhism

Christianity

It will also have a multi-faith space for resources that have been developed from an inter-faith perspective.

We are pleased to be taking part in the development of this resource, which will provide very positive publicity for our work.

We will need your consent for your child(ren) to take part in the filming, and I would therefore be grateful if you could consider whether you would be able to sign the enclosed form and return it to me by Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2014. I hope that you will feel able to allow your child(ren) to be part of this, but if you do not wish them to be involved, then please let me know, and I will make sure that this is respected.
