The children worked extremely hard yesterday to get the two pieces they are performing at the BBC Radio Leicester Carol Service this Sunday up to a very high standard. Please ensure the children arrive at St James the Greater Church promptly for 2pm (leaving enough time to find street parking on London Road) and are picked up and signed out with Stacey after the service at 5pm. Uniform is as usual, white shirt/blouse, black trousers or skirt and tights/white or black socks, black shoes. There will be a very large audience (around 500 people) so it is important the children look smart and their hair is neat and tidy. It would be a good idea to have a drinks bottle with them and perhaps a light snack to have between the rehearsal and the service.

The ticket allocations are as follows, they should be exactly as requested on the attendance forms you filled in. The service starts at 3pm and as its being recorded they won't let anyone in after this time. You can of course stay in the church when you drop off your children, and this is recommended to get a good seat! When you get to the door of the church, you will need to state your child's name to enter as audience members and they will have the list below. There will be no extra tickets as there is already a huge waiting list.
