As always I'd like to thank you for supporting the choir, especially to those of you who brought your children along to the service on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> May. ### **Collecting your child**

### **Fosse Singers Summer Concert in Leicester**

The other concert is a guest appearance in the summer concert of the Fosse Singers (of which I am also the conductor!) The concert is on **Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> July at 7.30pm** (day after the last day of term) in the Fraser Noble building in the centre of Leicester. This is a really exciting venue to perform in and we're hoping for a substantial audience, so this is an opportunity not to be missed!! The children will sing in the first half only and you may take young children home during the interval if you need to. There will be a short warm up, and rehearsal beforehand.
