

Dear parents/carers,

Herewith, details of the 'Captain Noah and His Floating Zoo' performances.

De Montfort Hall

The main performance will be at De Montfort Hall. We are doing a staged performance, so the children will have different roles to play and a small amount of movement. The performance at **De Montfort Hall** is part of a larger evening concert on **Wednesday 22nd June 2016**.

Schedule for the performance day - Wednesday 22nd June 2016:

- **10.45am:** Arrive at De Montfort Hall and assemble under the main canopy to the right or left of the entrance. (I will be there to meet you.)
- **10:55am** The choir will move into the Garden Suite ready to start their rehearsal at **11:00am**.
- **11:45am** The choir will move from the Garden Suite to the Stage and will rehearse until **12.30pm**.
- **12.45pm** Pick up the children from De Montfort Hall.
- **6.30pm** Children need to return back to the hall.
- The choir will meet in the foyer before entering the hall at **6.30pm** ready to watch the first half of the concert which starts at **7.00pm**.
- The choir will be performing in the second half of the concert, and will proceed to the stage area as a group during the **interval**, when directed. The concert will end at approx. **9.30pm**.
- Please collect children from the foyer at the end of the concert.

Tickets for the concert will go on sale on Friday 20 May, directly from the De Montfort Hall box office and on-line at <http://www.demontforthall.co.uk/> and will be priced at £10; £8 and £5 with £1 off those prices for concessions.

Unfortunately we are unable to provide or organise transport to and from De Montfort Hall, so please could you arrange this. You may like to arrange to share lifts with other parents - please arrange this amongst yourselves.

Performance at All Saints

The performance at All Saints will take place on Wednesday 29th June during

normal choir time. ie 4.45-6.15. The performance will start at 5.45 if you would like to come and watch (free entry with retiring collection for the children's choir and the church.)

Costumes

The children will wear simple costumes, as follows:

Those playing Noah and his family: please wear jeans and coloured tshirt for male characters (much like in Joseph) and female characters, please wear coloured skirts and coloured tops or a colourful dress.

Those playing animals: I will provide various masks, please could you provide black tops and black trousers or leggings and shoes - let me know if there is a problem with the black tops.

Please could you provide them with an umbrella if they have the word 'umbrella' by their name - if this is a problem I can get spares!
