Rachel's Leaving Service

As many of you will know already, Rachel Ross, our priest at All Saints is leaving, so to give her the excellent last service she deserves LCC and the All Saints church choir are joining forces for what will be an extravaganza of choral music throughout the holy communion service **this Sunday (23rd Feb)**. Please bring your child(ren) to the church in time to start at **9.30am** for the rehearsal. The service starts at 10.30am and will finish around 12pm. Do let me know if your child(ren) will be unable to attend.

Leicester Cathedral

Sunday 2nd March 9.20am-11.45am. This Cathedral Eucharist Service and presents an opportunity for the LCC to sing with the Cathedral boy trebles and songmen. Please drop and collect your children at St Martin's House which is next door to the Cathedral. There is no longer any parking at the Cathedral (due to landscaping work) but there are car parks nearby such as St Nicholas' Circle (Holiday Inn) and Highcross is a short walk away. The Cathedral and St Martin's House is located on Peacock Lane (please note this road is closed so access by car is difficult.) The best thing is to park and walk (as I assume most of you will want to come to the service) so leave plenty of time so we can start the rehearsal on time. The service is at 10.30am, so parent have even got time to nip into town for a coffee before it starts!

Uniform

For all events (unless otherwise stated) it is smart: white blouse or

shirt (preferably long sleeved) and black trousers or skirt and tights, and black shoes. The children will be provided with a burgundy neck ribbon (for girls) or bow-tie (for boys) at the venue.
