

Dear Parents and Carers,

Those of you who attended the WW1 concert with the children's choir on 8th November may have heard about plans All Saints has to reposition the war memorials in the church. I am writing to tell you that this work is starting this week and due to last nine weeks. This is quite a big undertaking involving a lot of building work in different parts of the church (not to mention a Heritage lottery grant). While this is taking place, various parts of the church are going to be completely cordoned off. The main area cordoned off will be the whole of the north aisle, i.e. aisle on the far side of the church when you come in. This will include the area where we normally serve drinks and biscuits. The other area likely to be cordoned off is the adult choir area, i.e. the area where the little organ sits.

Apart not being able to use certain areas of the church, I am hoping that our regular rehearsals in church are not going to be disrupted in any way. I have been told that the builders will be working on site between the hours of 8am to 4pm only, so there should be no work going on during our rehearsals. I will let you know if anything changes or I find out anything else that might affect you or your children.

On another matter, we have become short of helpers in the choir again due to a number of reasons. If any parent could offer help with the choir we would very much appreciate this. You don't have to help every week. In fact, we particularly want someone to help once every two weeks as we currently have a helper who wants to do this, but who is very kindly helping every week at the moment until we have someone to share her role. If you think you might be able to help, please could you see me after rehearsal one week.

Finally, this is just a gentle reminder to those who haven't yet paid their subscriptions for this term. These subscriptions are due by this Wednesday. Please could you hand your payment to Chris before or after the rehearsal this week. Thank you very much.
