

Dear Children's Choir parents

Firstly a huge thank you for your support of Loughborough Children's Choir. It has been a joy to watch the children grow in confidence over the last year and they make a wonderful contribution to the worshipping life of our church.

A couple of practical matters to note regarding rehearsals at All Saints.

As a town centre church we do on occasion have homeless people who are in need of the church's ministry. We seek to support them in a manner that looks after the safety and well being of all church visitors and volunteers. Whilst it is our policy to allow only recognised and authorised adults in to the church building during the Children's Choir rehearsal, from time to time other people may turn up unannounced. To manage this situation we have, as you know, taken the decision to lock the church door during rehearsals from 5pm to 6:05pm. We ask therefore that once you have dropped your child off you do not knock on the door to gain entry again until the designated unlock time. If you need to collect your child earlier on a specific occasion, please discuss this with Emma or Malcolm before you leave your child. If there is an urgent need for you to come in during the rehearsal, please call Malcolm [phone number deleted]. We shall be recruiting some other adults to help staff the door at drop off and pick up times.

On another matter, we are asking all church users at the moment to refrain from parking on the grass in order to give the grass chance to recover. We would very much appreciate your cooperation with this. Please make use of on street parking where possible.
