

Dear Parents / Carers,

WW1 concert is THIS SATURDAY 8th November. Please arrive at All Saints ready to start rehearsing at **6pm** in uniform: white shirt, black shoes and black trousers or skirt with black tights. I will bring the ribbons and bowties as usual. Let me know ASAP if your child is unable to attend, otherwise I will expect to see them on Saturday evening. There will be a break between the rehearsal and the concert, so you may want to provide your child with a packed tea and a drink. The concert starts at 7.30pm (tickets are £10 on the door, under 18s free). Parking will be available at Limehurst Academy for anyone attending the concert. LCC are only involved in the first half of the concert, so if you wish to collect your child during the interval, then I expect the first half to last about 30-45 mins so aim for just after 8pm and that should be about right. The children are welcome to stay and watch the second half which is The Armed Man by Karl Jenkins with choir and orchestra (I will be staying) - I envisage the concert will finish around 9.30pm.

Rehearsals end time

Thank you so much for accommodating the new rehearsal time on Wednesdays, however I'd like to make one final change, which shouldn't make too much difference, but the rehearsals will now run from **4.45pm-6.15pm** to make a nice round hour and a half. I do hope this won't be a problem.
