

Dear Parents,

Thank you for your child(ren)'s performance last night - it went really well! I mentioned to some of them about making decorations for our tree at the Christmas Tree Festival this year, as its only a week and a half away, please can you remind your children to make their musical themed decorations and bring them either this Wednesday (12th) or the following Wednesday 19th November when we'll be assembling the tree before choir practice and they can add their decorations as they arrive.

The Christmas Tree Festival concert is on Saturday 22nd November please arrive at 10.15am - the concert will begin at 10.30 and should finish about 11.30. It will take the form of choir pieces and solo performances from choir members, and will have a short break in the middle for the children to enjoy the Christmas trees.

Please don't leave it until the last minute, especially regarding the Sing Christmas live broadcast.
