Thanks for your support at the mayor's service, the choir did a great job and we had some lovely comments from the congregation and the church's adult choir members!

**1. RSCM area rehearsal** is this Sunday (22nd) at 2pm-3.30pm at All saint's. No need to wear uniform on this occasion. Its a rehearsal for the RSCM festival and will include adults from the church and the local area who are also taking part in the festival. I will be conducting the rehearsal and Malcolm will be playing. Its a good chance for the children to feel confident in singing the pieces for the festival and hearing them in 4 parts as well.

**2. RSCM festival** is on Sunday 29th Sept at St Mary's Church in Hinckley. You should have a paper letter about this. The uniform is as usual: white shirt, black trousers and black shoes (bows and bowties provided as usual).

**3. Weds 9th October:** the rehearsal just for that evening will be in Fearon Hall which is just next to All Saint's church. (Its the hall where we had refreshments after the Mayor's service for those of you who attended! We also had a rehearsal there around this time last year for those of you that remember that too.) If you go through the big gate to the church and turn left instead of right and follow the path round you'll come to Fearon hall. The room where we're rehearsing is on the left as you come through the door. Please ask one of us at the next rehearsal if you're not sure.

**4. Organ demonstration:** Malcolm is offering to do a demonstration of the organ after the rehearsal on Weds 2nd October for any children and parents who might be interested. Do stay, I'm sure it will be most enjoyable and enlightening!
