## **Celebration Communion at All Saints — Sunday 5th May 2013**

All Saints with Holy Trinity Parish Church, Loughborough.

Please arrive at **9.30am** for the rehearsal. The service starts at 10.30am and should last around an hour and 15 minutes.

### Music

Bread of the world, Lead me Lord, May God's blessing, and the Sanctus, Benedictus and Agnus Dei from the Communion Service in F by Harris plus a few congregational Hymns (TBC). This will be an exciting opportunity for LCC as they will be singing with men from the Leicester Cathedral Choir and the adult choir at All Saints.

### Family attendance

Family and friends are of course encouraged to attend this service and will be made very welcome by members of the church (as is, of course, the case with any service at All Saint's Church.) During the middle of the service, the children are invited to go out into the back room with the leaders of the Sunday children's group called 'Little Saints'. During this group the LCC is going help teach “May God's Blessing” to the children in “Little Saints” so that all the children can sing it together at the end of the service. Any other children attending the service such as brothers, sisters, or friends of the choir children are warmly invited and encouraged to take part in this also.

### Lunch

There will be a bring and share welcome lunch after the service to which everyone is invited and the choir are particularly encouraged to take part in. It would be nice for the children and parents to socialise with each other, as well as get to know other members of the church as we did back in November. If you would like to stay to lunch, please bring something to share, such as sandwiches, sausage rolls, salads, cakes etc.
